For all of us, madness lies just beneath the everyday...

This summer's intriguing must-read is a first novel that documents devotion, decline and delusion.

The precarious nature of our lives, especially as we enter our twilight years, is examined and dissected in **Devoted Sisters**, the first novel from new author **Alison Buck**, due to be published in the UK on **11th May 2006** by **Alnpete Press**.

This month a new voice in British fiction is published for the first time by Alnpete Press. Alison Buck's first novel, *Devoted Sisters*, is a study of decline; the slide into confusion and unreality of two elderly sisters. Living together in the house in which they were born, their precarious, yet reassuringly unchanging routine is shattered by the sudden and threatening intrusion into their lives of a stranger. His arrival marks the beginning of the end for the sisters and, as their mutual bonds of duty and love begin to unravel, their drift from reality to delusion is hastened by their regrets for opportunities lost long ago and the re-emergence of guilt for past, forgotten wrongs. But theirs is not an account of unrelieved darkness and despair: recollections of earlier, happier times lighten the sisters' story, while the author turns a questioning eye on the devotion that has underlain their shared lifetime of interdependence.

Alison Buck is an exciting and strong new voice in modern fiction. Although her stories feature powerful insights and express a female perspective on important issues and concerns they successfully speak to readers of all genders, ages and beliefs. Hers are dark, psychological dramas, mixed with wit and delivered with a light touch, that make you care about the hopes and dreams of her characters.
